

Prof. M. Subhan Qureshi: Short CV

Prof. M. Subhan Qureshi earned his DVM, MSc Hons, and PhD from the University of Agriculture, Faisalabad in 1998. After 22 years with the provincial livestock department of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Pakistan, he transitioned to academia at the University of Agriculture, Peshawar. His research spans animal health, reproduction, entrepreneurship, and biorisk management.

Prof. Qureshi has authored 65 impact factor articles, 3 book chapters, and 15 books. He has pioneered research in stress physiology and animal welfare, motivating faculty and students to secure research grants that address local challenges and explore business and industrial aspects of livestock and poultry production.

As the founder of Dairy Science Park, Prof. Qureshi has promoted the Triple Helix Model of Good Governance, fostering collaboration among academia, industry, and government. This initiative aims to generate exportable surpluses and create decent employment across the livestock value chain.

He also conceptualised the establishment of Livestock Technoparks in Peshawar and Quetta under FAO-UN and ITC-UN consultancies, respectively, and the Dairy Science Park Cairo at the request of ASRT-Egypt. Recently, he joined the National Eco-Security System initiative of ISN Beijing as President of NESS-Pak and offered the Khunjerab National Park of Northern Areas of Pakistan for eco-tourism, which was accepted by the International Alliance for Protected Areas.
