

Policy Statement: Gaza Ceasefire, Humanitarian Justice, and the Path to Sustainable Peace

Issued by Dairy Science Park (DSP) and National Eco-Security System Pakistan (NESS-Pak)

Peshawar, Pakistan — October 2025

Dairy Science Park and the National Eco-Security System Pakistan, working under the umbrella of the International Science Network (NESS-ISN), Beijing, issue this statement in response to the Gaza ceasefire and the urgent global call for justice, reconstruction, and sustainable peace. The initiative reflects our shared commitment to the Eco-Security Community with a Shared Future for Mankind, integrating peace, livelihood security, and environmental stewardship.

While the ceasefire brings temporary relief, continuing violations and political contradictions threaten lasting stability. The UN-endorsed Two-State Solution and the ICJ ruling on Gaza genocide must form the moral and legal basis for future arrangements. The U.S.-brokered framework, though helpful in ending hostilities, must not ignore UN resolutions or international accountability. The unilateral disarmament of Palestinian resistance before recognition of sovereignty undermines the right to self-determination guaranteed by the UN Charter.

Principles for a Just and Lasting Peace

1. Justice before Stability – Enforce the ICJ verdict through an international accountability mechanism ensuring prosecution of war crimes and reparations for victims.
2. Sovereignty and Reciprocity – Link any disarmament to recognition of a sovereign Palestinian State under UN supervision.
3. UN-Mandated Security Framework – Deploy a neutral, UN-approved stabilization force drawn from Muslim and non-aligned states.
4. Humanitarian and Livelihood Security – Rebuild Gaza's food, health, housing, and employment systems through DSP's Triple Helix Model of Good Governance connecting academia, industry, and government.
5. Integration into the Global Eco-Security Community – Embed Gaza's restoration within the Global Eco-Security Network, promoting coexistence, environmental responsibility, and collective prosperity.

A Call for Global Moral Leadership

We urge the United Nations, OIC, Arab League, EU, and all moral nations to: uphold international law without double standards; replace coercion with cooperation; and empower scientific, social, and faith-based institutions to rebuild peace through sustainable livelihoods. In the spirit of the Eco-Security Community with a Shared Future for Mankind, we reaffirm our pledge to pursue peace with justice, development with dignity, and security through sustainability.
